Poughkeepsie Farm Project (PFP) is a farm-based non-profit organization committed to cultivating a just and sustainable food system in the New York, Mid-Hudson Valley. On our member-supported farm in the City of Poughkeepsie, we grow fresh vegetables and fruit for our CSA, train future farmers, provide hands-on educational programs, and improve access to healthy locally-grown food. Our mission is to cultivate local leadership in sustainable farming, food access and education, and foster an inclusive, welcoming community for everyone. We have been serving the City of Poughkeepsie and our neighbors since 1999.

### **PFP's Key Programs**



#### Green Jobs for Youth

Our annual paid job training program for City of Poughkeepsie teens and young adults focuses on the leadership, farming and land stewardship skills needed to advocate for a more just and resilient food system.



#### **Farm to School**

PFP serves students and staff in Poughkeepsie, Kingston, New Paltz, Arlington and Broome-Tioga districts with farm visits, culinary workshops, and professional development training for educators and school nutrition staff.



#### Community Supported Agriculture

Our production farm produces 100,000 pounds of food annually, the majority of which reaches 430+ households participating in our Community Supported Agriculture program with weekly farm-based produce pick ups.



#### **Food Share**

This program improves access to nutritious and affordable sustainably-farmed food through donations to local emergency food partners, free produce distributions staffed by PFP educators, and Sponsored CSA Shares.



#### Community Culinary Arts & Education

PFP's culinary programs engage children and families in high-quality culinary experiences to encourage healthy cooking and eating at home through a variety of food based projects, including recipe kits and videos.



#### Seed Saving & Herbalism

Our educators lead young adults and teens in producing and distributing regionally adapted and open-pollinated seeds from our seed garden. We also grow culinary and medicinal herbs for workshops aimed to share culturally-relevant information about the use of herbs in health and healing.
